I have been advised that I should direct my enquiries about Unidentified Flying Objects (UFOs) to you.

Since January this year, as a civilian researcher, I have been permitted the first civilian direct review of the Royal Australian Air Force (RAAF) files on UFOs at the Russell Offices of the Australian Department of Defence in Canberra.

I have examined their extant files which cover the period from 1955 to 1982. This file review can be confirmed with Group Director of Air Force Intelligence and Security and the DAFI Intelligence Liaison Officer, with whom I have dealt directly.

The purpose of this letter is two-fold:

(1) To finalise my study I wish to understand the involvement of overseas countries on an official basis in investigating UFO sightings.

I would like to be advised of the extent and nature of MOD's file holdings on UFOs.

Do you have a yearly breakdown of reports recieved along with an indication of the number of unexplained cases each year?

Is MOD's approach to investigating UFO sightings merely to evaluate whether a security threat is apparent or does MOD take investigations further, perhaps to determine whether any body of "unexplained" reports constitute patterned data suggestive of unidentified and/or superiour technology?

Would it be possible to recieve copies of examples of the range of reports you recieve that MOD class as unexplained? I would only be interested in a few reports to compare with the type of reports evaluated as "unknown" by the RAAF. I appreciate that such reports would need to have the names and addresses of witnesses deleted.

- 1. We spoke reference the UFO incident which occurred on 19 Oct 82, when a USAF aircraft flying in the Eastern Mediterranean to the south of Cyprus reported an unidentified aircraft flying alongside. The incident was monitored by 280 SU and we have now received film of the 280 SU radar pictures and the tape on which radio transmissions were recorded.
- 2. We have very little to add to the information which is on the film and tape. However, you will wish to know that two USN F14 aircraft were launched from a carrier and an RAF Phantom, which was on a night flying exercise, were sent to assist. None of these three aircraft reported seeing the "UFO", nor was it seen on any ground or seaborne radar, including at 280 SU. We have a strong suspicion that the "UFO" was a mirage effect from lights on the coast of Israel or Lebanon.
- 3. We are arranging for a transcript to be made of the tape recording and will let you have both the transcript and the tape as soon as possible. We attach the film taken at 280 SU.
- 4. The US authorities wish to have copies of any reports which might result from your studies. We will arrange for them to receive a copy of the voice transcript.

PUBLICATION OF UFO REPORTS


- 1. As you are probably aware/Government spokesman in the House of Lords (on his own initiative I may add) told their Lordships on 7 April that there was no reason why they should not see the UFO reports received by the MOD. If we comply with this statement (and we cannot simply refuse without encouraging certain well known myths), then it is inevitable that the content of our reports will soon be widely dessiminated owing to the close links which many UFO societies maintain with various noble lords.
- 2. It seems to me therefore that if we are going to put UFO reports in the House of Lords library, we may as well make them generally available. There are a number of ways in which this could be done, for example
 - a. Publish reports as received, ensuring that they are all in the common format and that names/addresses have been deleted.
 - b. Publish all the reports for each month in a single batch, having taken the appropriate precautions.
 - c. Publish an annual UFO report containing an analysis of data received frequency, distribution etc.

The first proposal entails the risk that ufologists will descend upon the place with the 'latest sightings'; the last a lot of additional work. I am therefore inclined to favour the second proposal: we need not feel obliged to supply anything more than raw data, while the data supplied will be too old to cause too much trouble. Our public line on what we do with the reports would remain as present.

- 3. If we are to publish these reports, I believe we should charge for them a sum representing the cost, primarily labour, of preparing them for publication. We will be contacting GF3 separately on this matter.
- 4. I should be grateful for your views on these suggestions by the end of this month.
- 5. (For DI55b and Ops(GE)2) I am sure that I am not the only person to note the sharp fall in the number of UFO reports received since the beginning of the Falklands dispute. I have received one letter claiming that large numbers of UFOs have been seen in the vicinity of the Task Force presumably little green men in ponchos.



An international conference or symposium would also be useful Venice perhaps would be a suitable location.
